Having attended all meetings for the past 12 months which has been concentrating on the new Wildland PPC I can say if you haven't already heard from your Regional delegate it is now in production with an initial run of 1000 garments being produced. Back orders will be covered first and then stock put back on the shelves.

It was indicated during its development the complexity of the garment would likely lead to an increase in cost. One main factor for this is being the amount of extra fabric being used and the Aus\$. This will be addressed by the committee before the end of the year.

Other items of clothing are being considered which include polo shirts, day/night vest, waterproofs, car jacket, baseball caps etc.

The Uniform Manual has not been updated as to date, but can still be viewed on the CFS Website. It has not been transferred to the Volunteer Portal as yet.

It has been interesting representing the Volunteer Association on this committee and I am thankful for the opportunity, and look forward to the next year.
