The focus has been for the committee to close out a myriad of agenda items that have been on the action plan as far back as 2016.

Some include:

- WHS management systems for contractors
- The P2 mask action that was created by a PIN
- Cracking of Roo bars and general condition of refurbished vehicles
- New structure for conducting workplace inspections and the availability of volunteer's time to help conduct
- Revised reporting of notifications of hazards/serious injury reporting
- Define process for group/brigade HSR elections nominations
- Formulated workplace and asbestos inspection programme in conjunction with volunteer's time
- Addition of minutes to portal
- Monitoring of PFAS within CFS and the removal of from service
- Added demographics to the reporting system to build picture of age/sex from workplace injuries
- New claims still around smoke inhalation/slips/trips falls
- Sector comparison lower than other agencies
- 1st aid kits still in discussion and some groups have secured their own system (kangaroo Island) and other region 1 groups
