

## VOLUNTEER UNIQUE CODE NUMBER BOOKING INSTRUCTIONS - 2022/23

**PLEASE NOTE: These instructions are for the booking of park entry and camping ONLY. To receive the discount for other eligible park activities please contact the booking centre directly and provide your unique code.**

- Eligible volunteers may book one (1) complimentary campsite for up to five days, per booking.
- The eligible volunteer must be present at the booked campsite / when free park entry is claimed.
- If you need to cancel a booking, please do so as soon as practical so that the campsite can be made available for another user.
- Leave only your footprints when visiting or camping - please take your rubbish with you.
- The unique code number is not transferable.

### Booking a campsite online

1. Find your favourite park and camping site at [www.parks.sa.gov.au](http://www.parks.sa.gov.au) either:
  - a. From the search menu at the top right of the screen.
  - b. Using the **'Find a Park'** button on the home screen, search by park name, then select **'Book a Stay'**.
  - c. Using the **'Book & pay'** button on the home screen, search by park name, then select **'Book a Stay'**.
  - d. Using the Camping icon, search by park name, then select **'Book a Stay'**.
2. You will see a list of campground and accommodation options for that park. Find your campground and change the date so it suits the day you want to visit and select **'Book Now'**.

**Acraman Campground**  
Ikara-Flinders Ranges National Park



Nestled between two mountain ranges, this small campground surrounded by native pine trees is a short walk from Bunyerroo Gorge. The campground has 4 allocated campsites and is accessible by 2WD. Access: 2WD and 4WD.

Suitable for: tents, camper trailers. Facilities: long-drop toilet. Campfires: allowed (seasonal fire restrictions apply). Number of campsites: 4 allocated campsites. Unpowered. Water tank located at toilet block. NPWS cannot guarantee consistent water quality and supply.

- This will bring up a list of campsites within the campground. Find the site you wish to book, check the dates, nights, adults/children/infants at the top and select **'Book Now'**.

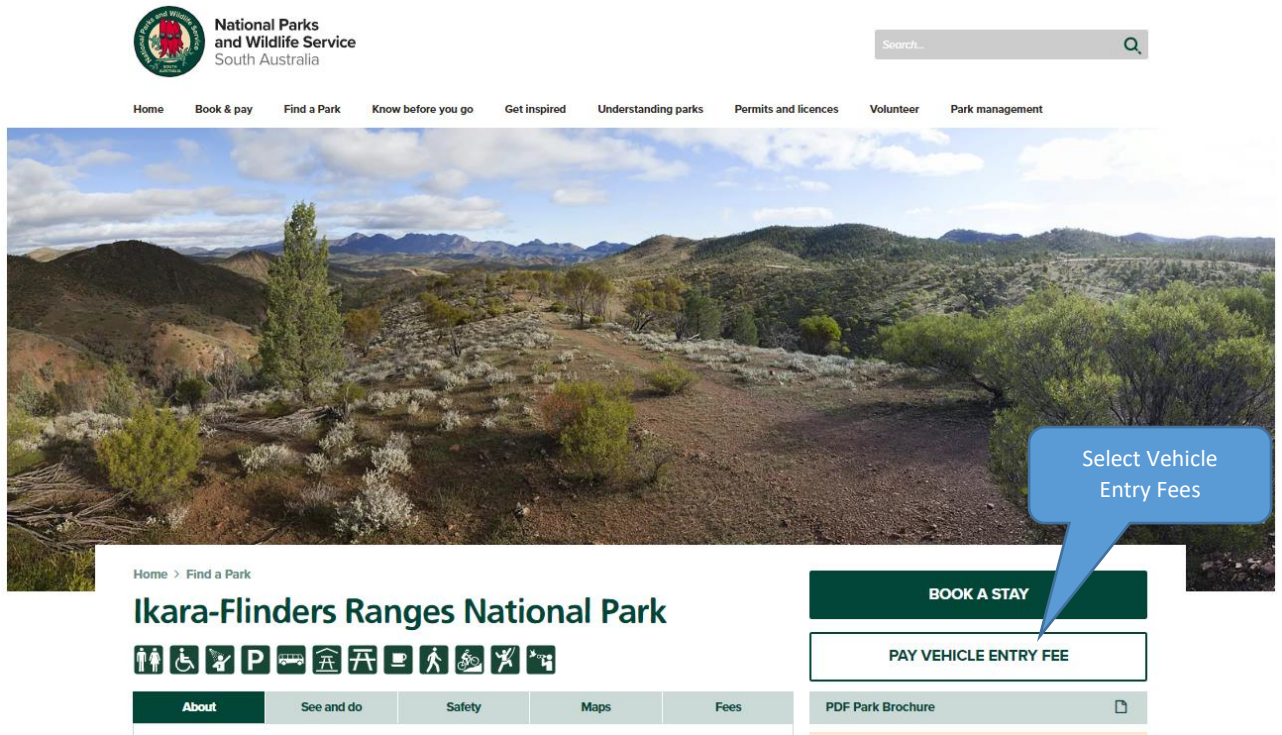

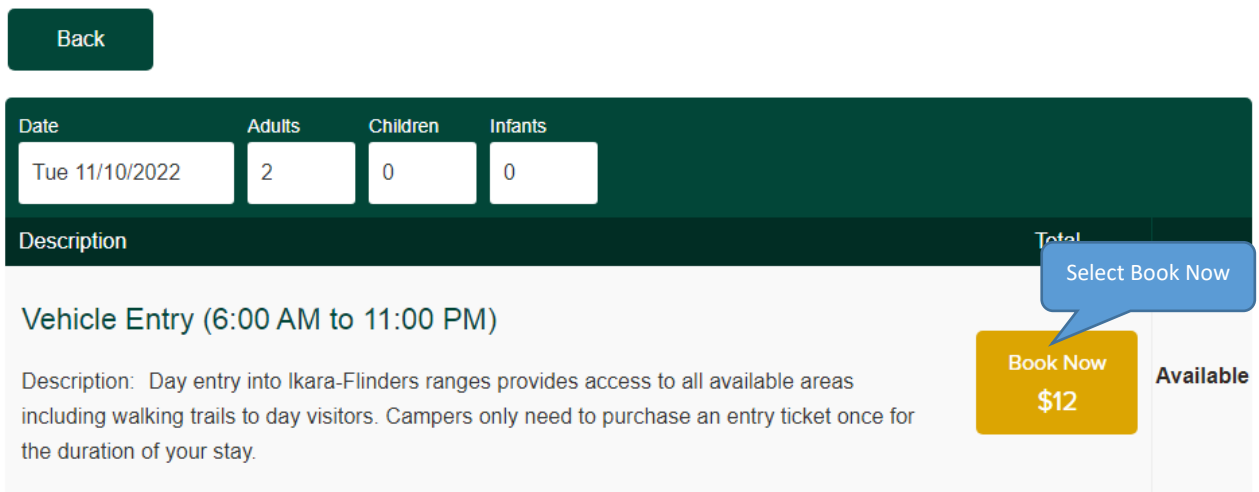
## Booking to visit a park for day entry

1. Find the park you wish to visit by typing in the park name in the search bar at [www.parks.sa.gov.au](http://www.parks.sa.gov.au)
2. Select the green 'Pay Vehicle Entry Fees' button located under the Book a Stay bar.



3. Check the dates, nights, adults/children/infants and adjust to suit, select 'Book Now'.
